We should, therefore, oppose all unscriptural developments with the energy and ability the Lord gives us, that in this dark and wicked world, we may be brighter lights to His honour and glory.

- 9) Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.
- 10) Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.

ARE YOU A WATCHMAN, ENGAGED IN BATTLE?

The Word of God states, in Jude verse 3, we should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints, or in other words, to engage in the battle. It is a plain fact that the Protestant Reformed faith is under threat today as never before - it is under threat from various sources including atheism, Islam, Ecumenism and Romanism. So why is the Church not active today? It is because God's people are not engaged in the battle.

Some people ask - why do organisations like Christian Watch exist? The answer is simple:

- a) The Church is not taking the Gospel message to the people.
- b) The Church is not opposing the evil in their communities.
- c) The Church has too many Ministers who take a neutral stance on virtually every issue so they don't jeopardise their cosy lifestyles and, in fact, has too many Ministers who do not even believe in the Word of God.

That's why Christian Watch exists.

So, I ask a simple question: does your heart burn to do something in the Lord's service, or do you want to just leave it to others? Do you desire to stand unashamedly for the Lord's cause and for the cause of the Gospel, but no leadership is given?

If you want to do something in the Lord's service, then that is what Christian Watch is all about. Let me briefly summarise some of the battlelines in which we, as Protestants, ought to be engaged.

- 1) We ought to be contending for the Protestant Reformed Christian faith and be a bulwark against further declension from the old paths.
- 2) We ought to adhere to the boundaries as laid down by the Word of God alone and defined by the great Confessions of Faith.
- 3) We ought to seek adherence to the Authorised Version of the Scriptures - the AV 1611 King James Bible - as being the most

accurate translation of the Scriptures into the English language.

- 4) We ought to expose the failings of modern Bible translations and their link with the spiritual declension in so many Churches today.
- 5) We ought to be in regular contact with Government Ministers at Westminster when Christian freedoms are threatened and Biblical standards of morality are challenged by the introduction of ungodly legislation. Abortion - or the murder of children - has been on the Statue Books for far too long; now we have all sorts of problems with gender and, of course, so-called same-sex marriage and civil partnerships. Why do these problems exist? They exist because men and women today do not know their Bible.
- 6) We ought to lobby against 'wolves in sheep's clothing' such as Ministers of local Churches who openly support godless lifestyles as being acceptable.

We need to be watchmen - watchmen engaged in the battle.

So, what is a watchman? What is the responsibility of a watchman? The job of a watchman in the Church is to sound the alarm at the erosion of our Christian liberties whenever and wherever they occur.

We must not leave it to others.

That is what Christian Watch is endeavouring to do.

What has happened to our Protestant voice today?

Christian Watch is endeavouring to stand in the gap. So, the question is: who is on the Lord's side? Are you willing to enlist in the battle?

We are contending for something valuable. We are contending for something in jeopardy - nothing less than the furtherance of the Gospel of Christ in our land and the maintenance of our Protestant heritage. *Earnestly contend for the faith* - contend for the faith that was once delivered unto the saints. Engage in the battle - don't leave it to others - be proud to be a Protestant - and God will give us the victory.

May God enable us by His grace to be soldiers for Jesus Christ - and to enlist in God's army.

Reader, what is your hope about your soul? Have you any, or have you none? Can you tell me in what way you expect to be accounted righteous before God?

Depend upon it, these are very serious questions. You and I are dying men. After death comes the judgment. What is our hope of acquittal in that awful day? What are we going to plead on our behalf before God?

Shall we say that we have done our duty to God? Shall we say that we have done our duty to our neighbour? Shall we bring forward our prayers, our regularity, our morality, our amendments, our church-going? Shall we ask to be accepted by God because of any of these things?

Which of these things will stand in God's eye? Which of them will actually justify you and me? Which of them will carry us clear through judgment and land us safe in glory?

None, none, none. Take any Commandment of the ten and let us examine ourselves by it. We have broken it repeatedly. We cannot answer God one of a thousand. Take any of us, and look narrowly into our ways, and we are nothing but sinners. There is but one verdict. We are all guilty, all deserve Hell, all ought to die. Wherewith can we come before God?

We must come in the name of Jesus, standing on no other ground, pleading no other plea than this, "Christ died on the cross for the ungodly, and I trust in Him."

Oh, believe me, Christ must be all the hope of every one who would be justified and saved. You must be content to go to Heaven as a beggar saved by free grace, simply as a believer in Jesus - **or you will never be saved at all.**
